# Background

- APEC Leaders at the Sydney Meeting in 2007 agreed to reduce energy intensity at least 25 percent by 2030 (with 2005 as the base year).
- APERC will assist member economies to realize this goal through a program called Peer Review on Energy Efficiency Policies (PREE);
- The PREE has two main components, namely:
  - Peer Review on Energy Efficiency Policies in volunteered APEC Economies; and
  - Compendium of Energy Efficiency Policies of APEC Member Economies under a common format.



# **The Compendium**

- The compendium is a collection of energy efficiency policies of all APEC member economies including goals and action plan (s) on energy efficiency improvement;
- The compendium is a basis for information sharing on energy efficiency policies and measures in the region;
- The compendium will serve as a source of basic information for conducting peer review in volunteered economies; and
- The compendium will be uploaded onto the APERC website with links from EWG and APEC Secretariat websites and updated periodically by APERC



# **Objectives of the Compendium**

- A part of the EWG progress report on energy efficiency cooperation to APEC Leaders at their meeting in 2010;
- Source for the APEC Energy Efficiency Database;
- Reference for APERC in the future study of energy efficiency potentials in the APEC region.



# **Structure of the Compendium**

- 1.Current Situation of Energy Consumption;
- 2.Economy's Goal/(s) on Energy Efficiency Improvement; and
- 3.Measures for Energy Efficiency Improvement.



# **Work Progress**

- APERC prepared questionnaire to gather information on APEC economies energy efficiency policies according to the common format approved by the EWG36 in Manila
- The questionnaire was circulated on 26 Dec 08 to all member economies and many APEC economies have filled and submitted the questionnaire
- APERC would like to seek continuous support by member economies to complete this program in timely manner
