## *9.c. (1) Objective of PRLCE*

### Objective of PRLCE:

- To assist **volunteer** APEC economy to promote low-emission power sources such as renewable energy, nuclear and fossil fuel with CCS by providing **recommendations** from APEC peer review experts.
- APERC is planning to further carry out analyses **on best practices** for efficient and effective policies to promote **low carbon power supplies** in APEC economies, and how such best practice policies can be applied, considering different conditions in different economies.



## ***9.c. (2) History and future of PRLCE***

- **Phase 1 (2012): Thailand, the Philippines**
- **Phase 2 (2013): Indonesia, Malaysia**
- **Phase 3 (2014/2015) Viet Nam** to be held in 2015 (originally scheduled in July, but the Vietnamese government requested to postpone it to September/October)
- **The project proposal of PRLCE Phase 3 was already approved for APEC budget.**
- **7 experts** (from **Australia, China, Hong Kong, New Zealand, the Philippines, Chinese Taipei, Thailand**) are scheduled to participate.
- **Workshop agenda of PRLCE is under preparation by the Vietnamese side and the review team.**
