APEC Energy Intensity Reduction Goal

- Based on APEC Demand and Supply Outlook (8th Edition), overall energy intensity declined by 26.1% between 2005 and 2020.
- APERC projected that APEC would achieve its energy intensity goal by 2034 and 2031 in Reference and Carbon Neutrality scenarios, respectively.
- APERC shared the main contributors and primary drivers of energy intensity reductions and demonstrated the policies from China and Japan as examples.

EGEE&C Governance Issues

- EGEE&C Term of References was reviewed by the members and without amendment.
- The selection of EGEE&C Chair and Vice Chair was held at the EGEEC 60 meeting and the results were circulated to members for endorsement.
- Members reached a consensus to select the following candidates as the EGEE&C Chair and Vice-chair for the tenure from 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2025.
 - EGEE&C Chair: Dr Liu Meng China
 - EGEE&C Vice-chair: Ms Jovian Cheung Hong Kong, China
- EGEEC Contact List was updated and circulated to members on 9 March 2023.
